THE SPRING FEASTS SUMMARY

Dominate 'In The Power of His Resurrection'

"That I may know Him and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death" Philippians 3:10 NKJV

Spring Feasts - Intent & Purpose

Is for the Saints of God to:

- 1. To Know Him
 - Continually strive to be one with Him
 - Transition from a causal relationship to an intimate relationship
- 2. Live by Faith and Experience the Power of His Resurrection
 - Testimonies of-
 - Achieving
 - Succeeding
 - Overcoming
- 3. Conform to Christ's Death and Experience the Same Resurrection that He did
 - Be strong: Not be weary during tests and trials
 - Arise victoriously from trying circumstances

Fellowship with Christ Involves Participating in His Death and Resurrection

- Paul wanted to know Jesus more intimately. (Triumph and Trial)
- Paul wanted to experience a relationship that was more than just head knowledge.
- Paul believed it to be perfection to have victory over sin, suffering and death, as Jesus did.
- He felt persevering through suffering is a way to identify with Christ suffering on Calvary and transform in the image of Christ. (He wanted to imitate it)
- Fellowship in the power of His resurrection is experiencing the wonder-working power of God in your life and situations.
- Master walking in continual victory by the power of God.

THE SPRING FEASTS

And the Lord spoke to Moses saying, "Speak to the children of Israel, and say to them: The feasts of the Lord, which you shall proclaim to be holy convocations, these are My feasts." Leviticus 23:1-2

The Spring Feasts consist of four festivals: Passover, The Feast of Unleavened Bread, The Feast of First Fruits, and Pentecost (The Feast of Weeks). These feasts are significant because they teach us to honor God for who He is and what He has done for us. In addition, they teach us about God's redemptive plan for mankind and how He powerfully intervenes in human affairs! Revelation 21:3 says "Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and He will dwell with them, and they shall be His people. God, Himself will be with them and be their God."

PASSOVER

Passover begins at sundown, April 12th, and ends at sundown, April 20th. This Feast commemorates God delivering His people from bondage in Egypt. It also introduces God's redemptive plan for mankind through the shed blood of Jesus Christ as the Passover Lamb for all. Jesus Christ is the fulfillment of the Passover. He is the Lamb of God, sacrificed to set us free from the bondage of sin. The blood of Jesus covers and protects us, and His body was broken to free us from eternal death. For many, Passover and the Feast of Unleavened Bread are both observed during Passover; however, we will not be participating in the Passover Seder meal.

- Maundy Thursday, (<u>April 17th</u>) from 6:00pm-7:30pm (Foot-Washing Ceremony Only for Core Team Leaders, MEDs, Pastors & Resurrection Production Cast). Maundy Thursday, also referred to as Holy Thursday of the Supper of the Lord, among other names, is a solemn Christian feast during Holy Week that marks the beginning of the Paschal Triduum, and commemorates the Washing of the Feet (Maundy) and Last Supper of Jesus Christ with the Apostles, as described in the canonical gospels. It is the fifth day of Holy Week, preceded by Holy Wednesday (Spy Wednesday) and followed by Good Friday. "Maundy" comes from the Latin word mandatum, or commandment, reflecting Jesus' words "I give you a new commandment."

THE FEAST OF FIRST FRUITS

The words First Fruits mean "a promise to come." On the day of First Fruits, <u>Sunday</u>, <u>April 13</u>, <u>2025</u>, the Church Family will bring a special offering to the Lord. This offering will represent the First Fruits of any financial income since the Feast of Tabernacles which was held (in April 2024). In Leviticus 23:9-14, the first crops of the barley harvest were offered to God (add joy campaign info here) as an offering of thanksgiving for the promise of an abundant harvest. This offering, lifted up to the Lord, is called the early First Fruits. In I Corinthians 15:23, Jesus is considered the First Fruit of the harvest of all who have died in Him. This Feast was fulfilled when Jesus rose from the dead and ascended into heaven. For Christians, this Feast is important because it celebrates the resurrection of Jesus Christ!

Things You Need to Know

- The Feast of First Fruits begin at sundown, Sunday, April 13th, and ends sundown, Monday, April 14th.

MAUNDY THURSDAY (April 17th)

Maundy Thursday is the fifth day of Holy week, a Christian observance also known as Holy Thursday or Covenant Thursday that falls every year on the day before <u>Good Friday</u>. The day commemorates for Christians the last supper where Jesus Christ consecrated bread and wine initiating Holy Communion or the sacrament "Eucharist".

DOMINATE

In the Power of Pentecost Acts 1:8

"But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." Acts 1:8 NKJV

"But the Holy Spirit will come on you and give you power. You will be my witnesses. You will tell people everywhere about me – in Jerusalem, in the rest of Judea, in Samaria, and in every part of the world." Acts 1:8 ERV

THE FEAST OF PENTECOST (Feast of Weeks)

The Feast of Pentecost commemorates the giving of the Holy Spirit as in the New Testament. This feast is to be filled with joy and thanksgiving for God's bountiful blessings of the harvest. During the celebration of Pentecost, believers will bring the First Fruits of any financial income since the Passover. This offering is called the latter First Fruit offering and symbolizes our thanksgiving to God for providing the "latter" spring harvest. You are welcome to sacrifice more; however, we encourage you to allow the Holy Spirit to determine the amount of your special offering.

Pentecost

- A Christian holiday that takes place 50 days after the Resurrection.
- Pentecost is recognized by the "Sound" from heaven like a rush of might wind and the "Tongues of Fire".
- It celebrates the descent of the Holy Spirit and the empowerment of the disciples.
- It marks the birth of the church.

Pentecost - Intent & Purpose

Call-to-Action to Share the Gospel of Jesus Christ:

- 1. Pray that the Holy Spirit will work in us.
- 2. Pray for a conviction that exposes all prejudices.
- 3. Stir-up a compassion for the broken and the lost.
- 4. Be compelled, moved to give of ourselves and resources to share the message of Jesus Christ.
